



**RU21 BEST PRACTICES PROGRAM**  
**Pre-Agreement to Reduce Secondary**  
**Sales of Alcohol to Minors**  
*10 Points*

This pre-agreement document serves as a promise and commitment to work with the Wright County Sheriff's Department on reducing secondary sales of alcohol.

An example of a secondary sale would be if a customer gave their alcoholic beverage to an underage person. If a server sees this action happen they need to intervene and call the Wright County Sheriff's Department to report the secondary sale. The adult providing the alcohol to the minor would be charged for providing alcohol to the minor.

Also, as part of this agreement, servers must card customers who look 40 years old and younger and re-card customers who move to their section or area of work (in order to ensure they are indeed of age). If a customer tries to purchase a pitcher of beer or multiple beverages all ID's of those who will be consuming the beverages need to be viewed and all the customers need to provide their ID in person to the server.

For off-sale businesses, sellers need to be able to view if secondary sales are occurring in the parking lot. A well-lit parking lot or video cameras can help view such illegal secondary sales. If an employee/seller views a secondary sale, they should call the Sheriff's Department and report the incident.
