Ordinance O-22-09

An Ordinance amending Delano City Code Chapter 8, Section 812.01 related to Firearms and Dangerous Weapons Regulations

The City Council of the City of Delano Ordains

**Section 1.** City Code Chapter 8, Section 812.01, Subd. 1, is amended by deleting Subsection D in its entirety and re-lettering existing Subsection E as Subsection D.

**Section 2.** City Code Chapter 8, Section 812.01 is amended by deleting Subdivision 3 in its entirety and renumbering existing Subdivisions 4 through 7 accordingly.

**Section 3.** City Code Chapter 8, Section 812.01, Subd. 4 (as renumbered in Section 2 of this ordinance), is amended in the first line by deleting the first sentence and replacing it with the following:

Notwithstanding the general prohibition of Subdivisions 3, the following individuals may discharge firearms or dangerous weapons in the City as described below:

**Section 4.** City Code Chapter 8, Section 812.01, Subd. 4 (as renumbered in Section 2 of this Ordinance), is amended by deleting Subsection C in its entirety and replacing it with the following:


C. Persons engaged in the use of bow and arrows under the following circumstances:


1. On school district property for educational purposes, subject to appropriate supervision by authorized school district personnel;
2. On private property owned by such person or with the consent of the owner;
3. On a field or archery range and course located on City property and operated by the City, subject to the rules and requirements of the City.

In all circumstances permitted by this Subdivision 4.C, use of bow and arrows: (a) is limited to arrows tipped with practice or field tips only; (2) must be in such a manner as to prevent the arrows from leaving the limits of the permitted property; and (3) must not pose an unreasonable risk of bodily harm to any individual.

**Section 5.** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately following its passage and publication.
