Ordinance No. O-22-07

An interim ordinance establishing a moratorium prohibiting the applications for and/or the issuance of permits or zoning approvals for billboard signs within the City of Delano, Minnesota

The City Council of Delano Minnesota ordains:

Section 1. It is the intent of this Interim Ordinance to allow the City of Delano, Minnesota to complete a review of the presently existing zoning ordinance section 51.03, Subd. N.6 Billboards regulating the location, size, height, and design of billboards allowed within the City. The City will study the current regulations and make appropriate changes in the ordinance in order to protect the value of properties within the City of Delano, to ensure proper land use controls, and design standards are in place to facilitate compatibility between such uses and the surrounding property uses.

Section 2. Authority and Purpose. The City Council is empowered by Minn. Stat. 462.355, Subd. 4 to pass an interim ordinance, applicable to all or a portion of its jurisdiction, for the purpose of protecting the planning process and health, safety, and welfare of its citizens.


Section 3. Temporary Prohibition. For one year after the effective date of this ordinance, or until such earlier time as the Delano City Council determines by resolution that the reasons for the moratorium no longer exist, no permits shall be issued for, nor shall the City receive, consider, and/or approve, any application, of any type, which proposes to locate a billboard within the City of Delano.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and shall remain in effect until one year after the effective date unless a shorter period of time is approved by the proper resolution of the Delano City Council.
