## Background

The City of Delano and Franklin Township have partnered on a Wright County grant project to repair a section of County Ditch 34. Construction documents have been developed and posted for bids in December/January. A total of 16 bids were received from interested contractors on January 14, a summary of the bids received is shown below:
